GAPS IN EDUCATION:

May 13th 2004 to November of 2004: I had just graduated from medical school in Germany (May 13th 2004) and was studying for USMLE II and mainly completing my PhD Dissertation in Munich, Germany. My father suffered a massive hemorrhagic stroke that left him hemiplegic in September of 2004. During that period (9/04) to (11/04) I had to fly emergently to Greece until it was clear that he would survive, then returned to Munich, finished and submitted my dissertation, took STEP 2 and returned to Greece to assist my mother with his care until he was able to go to rehab. I left Greece to go to New York and start a research fellowship the day he was taken to the rehab hospital, in November of 2004. November 2004 to March of 2006: I was a clinical research fellow for Spine Surgery at the hospital for Special Surgery in New York. This is reflected in numerous publications and the attached certificate. March of 2006 to July of 2006: I flew to Montreal to present a paper at Spine Arthroplasty Society Meeting, I returned to Munich to submit the dissertation wwaase 2 then went to Greece for bureaucratic obligations: I was accepted for my Residency in Kentucky on a J1 visa and I had to a) get my medical school diploma accredited in Greece b) matriculate in a medical board in Greece, c) obtain

a letter of medical necessity. This process and documents were prerequisites for the J1 visa and sea my physical presence in Greece. In July of 2006 I started my residency.

Prior to starting my practice and at the end of my fellowship, from 08/01/13 - 10/14/13 I simply took a hiatus for personal reasons.

With my wife and daughter we spent a month visiting family in Greece, then a month in Spain and then 2 weeks to move into new apartment, acclimatize, get furniture, school for my daughter, orientation for hospital.
